1. Purpose

Research Center for Nonwritten Cultural Materials invites a young researcher from your institution to foster the person who will become skilled at handling nonwritten cultural materials.

2. Information

- A. Number of Applicant      One
- B. Implementation Period      From September 28<sup>th</sup> 2015 to February 29<sup>th</sup> 2016  
\*Applications should be received at least 3 months in advance of the preferred visiting date
- C. Visiting Duration      From 14days to 21days  
Notice: Include the schedule of coming and going  
Not allow to stay over visiting duration  
Except new year's holiday season (12/26-1/6)
- D. Qualification
- ① A graduate school doctoral program enrolled student or a doctoral program graduate  
However if no one is suitable for this qualification, we would also accept a young researcher in or after master program of a graduate school has one of following qualifications.  
The person who
- a. Has ever published a dissertation in an academic magazine (include university's bulletin)
  - b. Has ever presented papers in a congress, workshop or symposium
  - c. Has job experience (associate professor, assistant professor, teaching assistant, etc.),engaged in research
  - d. Has ever been a part-time instructor and lectured in university
- ② Should have a relevant research theme of "Nonwritten Cultural Materials"
- E. Expense
- ① Our Allowance
- a. Living cost (10,000yen per day)
- ② By yourself
- a. Air ticket (round trip)
  - b. Overseas travel accident insurance (on duty)
  - c. Visa application fee (if necessary)

3. Requirement

- ① Should attend the meeting of our research center and present papers on your research in Japan
- ② Should submit your report to us in writing one of the following ways after going back to your country
  - a. Approx. 4000 letters in Japanese
  - b. Approx. 2000 words in English
  - c. Approx. 3000 letters in Chinese
